Clear impact on patient care

Brian Williams, MD, says Vatica is one of several coding and documentation programs they use from seven different health plans, but Vatica tops the list.

"For our practice, the first 'toe in the water' toward transitioning to value-based care was our contract with Vatica. We made a concerted effort to ensure that some of the savings from this work is shared with physicians.

Better patient care

Dr. Williams cited the case of a patient who had aortic atherosclerosis noted on a CT of the abdomen. He was not aware of the test or the diagnosis, which was flagged prior to the patient's visit on Vatica's Pre-Encounter Provider Notification. The diagnosis has been added to the problem list and is under active management.
